Reports


Student reports provide students, teachers and parents with a clear and concise picture of a student's achievement and progress at a point in time. Teachers make informed and consistent decisions about student progress against the achievement standards using a variety of assessments and observations to inform their judgement. They map the student's learning against the achievement standards, and place the student on the learning continuum that best reflects the student's level of performance and progress.

This year the Evatt Schools software was updated from Windows 7 to Windows 10 and that change created several formatting challenges for our reports. You might notice in your child's report some print looking as if it were bolded. This did not appear on the screen during proof reading, but appeared on the paper after the reports were printed. As a school that prides itself as having a strong focus on sustainability we decided to not engage in a reprint, and hope you appreciate that we did not want to reprint 330 reports involving double the use in paper.





Using gas bottles this Summer? Tips to stay safe.

Did you know that you should never lay down even an empty gas bottle when transporting it? And that gas bottles should be checked before you use them?

Keep yourself and others safe by practising a few simple safety tips when using LP gas bottles. These important tips apply when planning BBQs, camping, boating or caravanning this festive season.

LP gas bottles are safe when connected and used correctly. They should however never be used indoors or in confined spaces or connected or disconnected near an open flame. You can quickly and easily check for gas leakages by squirting soapy water on the gas connections and hoses - if bubbles start forming, there is a leak. Leaks are often due to damaged or missing O rings or rubber bull nosing, or if connections are not tight. After replacing the damaged or missing rubber rings and tightening the connections it is important to turn the gas back on and test again with soapy water.

If bubbles are still forming, do not use the gas appliance but instead contact a licensed gas fitter.

There have been several cases in the last two years where portable gas cylinders have ignited in vehicles causing an explosion - even when bottles were thought to be empty and turned off. It is preferable that gas bottles are transported in open air vehicles like a trailer or ute and be secured with straps or in a container in an upright position, never lying down.

If this is not possible you can transport gas cylinders in the boot of your car – never on a passenger seat or in the foot well. It's also important to wind your car windows down as this provides more ventilation in the vehicle.

For safety reasons, gas bottles should not be left in an enclosed vehicle unnecessarily, especially in the hot sun, and no more than two cylinders should be transported in a vehicle at a time.
