Unfortunately, there has been a delay at the national level with a number of states arguing the validity as there were a range of test models used. Some states pulled out of using the online platform, others were not even consistent in their own state using both electronic and paper tests.

# Preschool News

To celebrate Science Week, preschool had Peter from the Reptile Zoo come and teach us about reptiles and amphibians. We learnt about where reptiles live, what they eat and how they protect themselves. We got to meet a tree frog called Booga. We learnt that Booga actually drinks through his skin and chews with the muscles in his eyes! We also got to meet and pat a variety of lizards including a blue tongue, a frill neck and a shingleback. The shingleback had a tail that looked



exactly the same as its head. We learnt that this is the 'bluff' it uses to protect its eyes from predators. We also got to meet two long neck turtles. Did you know that if a long neck turtle is stuck on its back, it can use its long neck to push itself back on to its belly. Also, long neck turtles can live as long as humans! One of the most exciting parts of the incursion was when we met a baby crocodile called Chopper! Peter put a hair

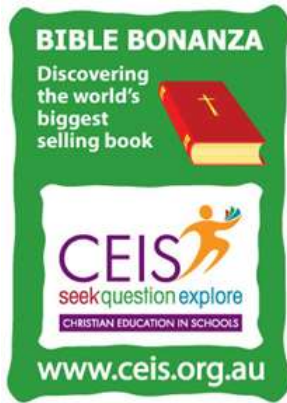
tie around its snout so he wouldn't bite us while we had a pat. The top of his body felt very hard like armour and his belly felt soft like marshmallows. Most children had a pat and some children were more comfortable just watching. Last but not least, was a beautiful python called Crystal. Her scales felt dry and smooth.



Being so close to these reptiles and amphibians was such a special experience and with Peter's wealth of enthusiasm and knowledge, we were thoroughly entertained.
