Dear parents and carers,

It is time again to start preparing for next year by ordering school supplies and considering payment of the voluntary contributions.

In a very competitive market, this year we have acquired an excellent deal with the stationery providers if we buy in bulk for all students. In the past we have found that students who buy their own book packs from different providers do not buy the correct items or the items are of inferior quality.

We would like to encourage all parents to buy the stationery requirements through the school. Staff have spent considerable time selecting products that students will need to enhance their learning. School supplies through these specialist school providers ensure that the products are high quality, age appropriate and ensure class consistency. Such things as thickness of pencils, line spacing in exercise books and lasting colours for textas have all been considered. Some of the products we use can only be purchased through a school supply provider such as handwriting books. We hope that paying for the supplies from school will also save you time and money.

An amount of \$70 per student will cover these costs for the year.

In addition to having appropriate writing equipment, the payment of voluntary contributions is extremely valuable for ensuring that the school can provide many of the other resources needed at school. This enables us to buy other essential items such as reading books, copy paper, maths and English resources and many other items to enhance your child's learning. We ask that you also select to pay this. There are discounted amounts for families with 2, 3, or more children, and payment can be made upfront or in instalments by electronic transfer or by cash. If you nominate your voluntary contribution to the library fund this amount is tax deductible.
